

Green Lake School District Academic Standards

State and National Academic Standards specify what student should know and be able to do in the classroom at a given point in time. Some academic standards used are specific to individual content areas and other are transdisciplinary. The Green Lake School District sets high expectations for students based on the following:

- GLSD has used the Common Core Standards for English/Language Arts and Mathematics as a guideline for instruction since the state adopted them in June, 2010.
- GLSD uses the Common Core Standards for Disciplinary Learning throughout the curriculum to support literacy in all subject areas.
- Wisconsin Academic Standards are used as guidelines to support instruction in PE, Art, Music, Health, Social Studies, Technical Education, etc.
- The district uses Next Generation Science Standards which were built from the National Research Council of Science and ACT College and Career Readiness Standards in Science.
- Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards are used in the 4K program.
