

**School District of Green Lake
Minutes of Small Parcel
Detachment Hearing**
February 18, 2009

The small parcel detachment hearing of the School District of Green Lake was held Wednesday, February 18, 2009, in the school library media center. The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by chairperson, Wendy Schultz.

Notice of this meeting was given to all district approved locations.

Chairperson Wendy Schultz read a statement identifying her as Chairperson for the detachment hearing.

Motion by Reabe, second by Deyo to appoint Shelley Eilbes secretary of the special district meeting. All ayes - motion carried.

Ms. Eilbes read the Notice of Hearing: Petition to Alter School District Boundaries.

Mrs. Schultz recognized the following board members were present: Wendy Schultz, Dennis Deyo, Amy Pipho, Harley Reabe. Absent: Celest King, Jodine Depsich, Gordy Farrell.

Ken Bates, District Administrator presented the Green Lake District's statutory basis for making a decision. (Attachment A).

Mrs. Schultz presented an overview of the petition. (Attachment B).

Charles Van Scyoc of N4322 Lakeshore Drive, petitioner, addressed the Board with his reasons for requesting the detachment from the Princeton School District and attaching to the Green Lake (Attachment C).

There were no opponents comments or additional information presented.

Mrs. Schultz closed the public presentation and opened the school board deliberations.

Mr. Reabe feels that it will be to the districts advantage to count the students as enrolled instead of open-enrolled.

Motion by Deyo, second by Pipho to grant the Detachment.

A paper ballot was distributed and tallied by the secretary. Ms. Eilbes announced the vote was 4-0 to grant the reorganization requested in the petition.

Mr. Reabe introduced a resolution authorizing issuance of an order, "Whereas, a meeting of the school board of the Green Lake School District was held on February 18, 2009, and Whereas, a petition has been filed with the clerk of the school board, pursuant to s.117.11-13, Wis Stats., proposing to detach property from the Princeton School District and to attach it to the Green Lake School District, and Whereas, a public hearing has been held on the proposed reorganization by the school board pursuant to s.117.11-13, Wis., Stats., Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that an order is issued

and filed granting the petition upon which said hearing has been held.”
Seconded by Deyo. All ayes.
Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Reabe, second by Pipho to adjourn the small parcel detachment hearing at 6:55 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried 4-0.
