361.2 – Selection of Library Materials

The Board of Education firmly believes that the appreciation for literature and ability to read sets the foundation for future learning and enjoyment. Responsibility for the selection of library materials shall, however, be delegated to the professional library media center staff within the limitations of the budget.

Although the final decision for all purchases shall be made by qualified personnel, recommendations and requests are encouraged by students, staff, parents, community members, and anyone connected with the district.
