GREEN LAKE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S HOMEWORK CLUB BEGINS!!

Dear Students and Parents,

I am pleased to inform you that the Green Lake School District Homework Club is available to students in grades 2-7 and will begin on Monday, October 16, 2017. Homework Club is held in the school library from 3:15 pm to 4:15 pm. The program runs after school, Monday through Thursday. The program does not meet on Fridays or on the school day prior to a school recess day. For example, we will not meet on Thursday, March 1st because we do not have school on Friday, March 2nd.

Homework Club will provide time for students to get academic support from tutors as they complete some of their homework assignments. A light snack will be provided. Students will not be allowed to play video games, wander the building, or just "hang out" while at the program. All students should have a book to read or coursework to study should they finish their assignments. Students will be expected to stay in the supervised area. The same policies that are in place for classroom and schoolwide behavior will pertain to the after school tutoring program. Should any student show disrespect for others, including the tutors, a parent will be notified. Bullying and disruptions will not to be tolerated.

Registration is required before students begin attending. Registration forms should be returned to the front office.
