IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONTINUED

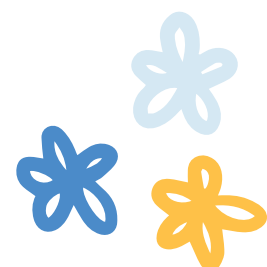
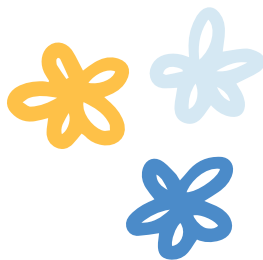

Drop off & Pick up information: Drop off time will be 8:30 am and pickup time will be 12:00 pm. Please drop off and pick up in the carpool lane.

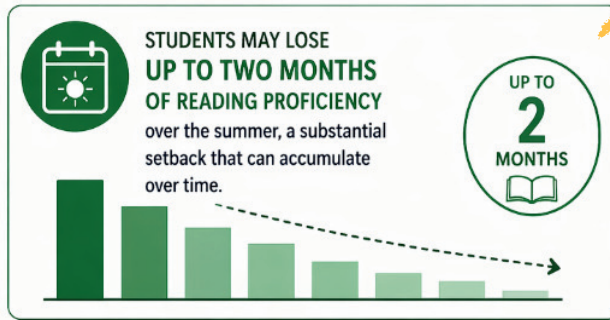
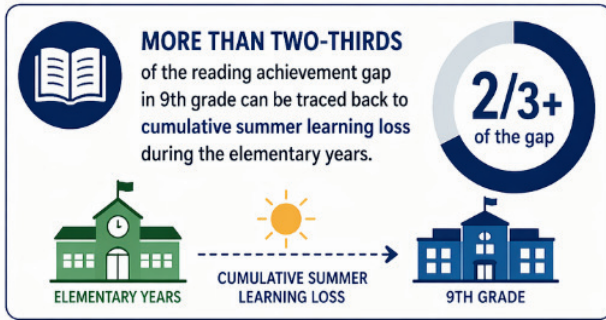
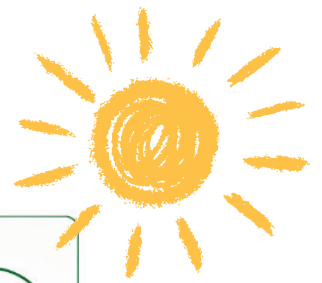


SUMMER INVESTIGATIONS

- Helps to create a smooth transition into the next level of math and English study.

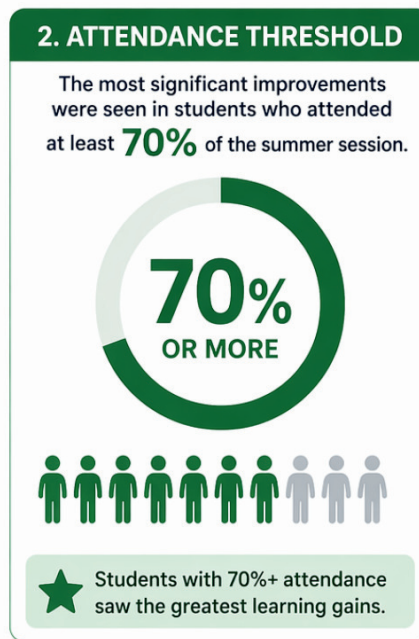
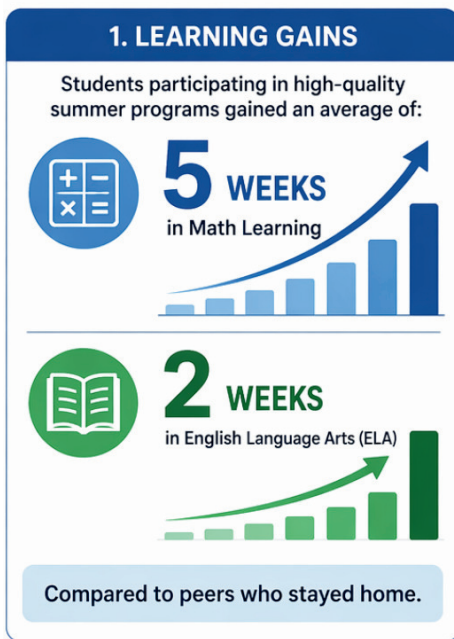


WHY SUMMER SCHOOL MATTERS


