166 – Board Use of E-Mail

Electronic mail (e-mail) and computer transmissions by members of the Green Lake School District Board under some circumstances may be considered a meeting under the Wisconsin Open Meeting Laws. Therefore, subject to applicable board policies, e-mail will be used by the board members only for the purpose of communicating the following matters:

- 1. Messages between board members or between board members and employees that do not involve the interactive exchange of information or opinions constituting discussion, deliberation, or decision-making on subjects within the realm of the board's authority;
- 2. Possible meeting agenda items between the superintendent and the board president;
- 3. A board meeting agenda or public record information pertaining to district operations;
- 4. Requests for public record information pertaining to district operations;
- 5. Responses to questions posed by members of the public, administrators or school staff.
