	Board Operations

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All meetings of the Board of Education shall be open to the public, except those authorized by law to be closed, and the order of business shall include an opportunity for citizens to address the Board.

Members of the public will be permitted to speak to the Board of Education. The following procedures are established to provide maximum public input and to ensure the orderly conduct of the meeting.

Citizens wishing to speak shall register with the Secretary of the Board prior to the meeting. The speaker shall specify name, address, and the topic for discussion. The President of the Board shall determine when it is appropriate for the speaker to make the presentation. The speaker's remarks shall be limited to three minutes during the public comment time, or as an agenda item at the next board meeting.
