Board Operations

189 – Board Member Meeting Participation

The Green Lake School Board's business requires the active and direct attention of all Board members. Conducting Board business via telephone conference, video-conference, or other technology is not a substitute for the in-person dialogue and exchange of views that occurs at Board meetings. Accordingly, absent further action by the Board, a Board member will be counted in the quorum of a Board meeting and be permitted to participate in discussion and voting only when the Board member is physically present at the meeting. No individual Board member may be excluded from any meeting of the Board at which he/she is physically present. However, an individual Board member has no right to insist upon the ability to participate, in any capacity, in any Board meeting remotely via telephone conference or other technology.
