Instruction

342.6 – Program and Curriculum Modifications

The Green Lake School District shall strive to meet the educational needs of all students enrolled in the District, help each student develop to his/her maximum potential, and pace the educational programs to reflect a variety of learning rates and styles.

The Board recognizes that program or curriculum modifications may occasionally be called for to meet the individual needs of certain students. Therefore, the Board shall consider program or curriculum modifications at the request of individual students and/or their parents/guardians.

Students and parents/guardians shall be notified of available program or curriculum modifications at the beginning of each school year in accordance with state law requirements, District policies and procedures.
