## 345.11 - Class Rank

The Board of Education acknowledges the usefulness of a system of computing grade point averages and class ranking for high school students, both to inform students of their relative academic placement among their peers and to provide students, prospective employers, and institutions of higher learning with a predictive device so that each student is more likely to be placed in an environment conducive to success.

A student that transfers into Green Lake School shall have their grades transfer on an A through F grade scale. GPAs that are based on other scales shall be transferred to our scale by the guidance counselor.

Any Pass/Fail grade will not be averaged in to the overall GPA.

Class rank is determined by the cumulative GPA where the sum of grade points earned is divided by the total number of credits taken.
