345.3 - Homework

The Green Lake School District recognizes that homework supports the school district's curriculum and the following guidelines will make the roles of teacher, students and parents more effective.

The teacher should guide each child in developing good study skills and provide opportunities for independent practice. When homework is assigned, the teacher should see that the student has the necessary instruction prior to doing the work. After homework is completed, the teacher should review the work and provide timely feedback to the student about his or her accomplishment.

Students are responsible for effective completion of homework. Beginning in the third grade, students have the responsibility for contacting the teacher to clarify assignments that they do not understand.

As partners with the school, parents help to make student's homework effective and meaningful. They should provide an appropriate place to study, monitor the study process, and interact with the student in areas where it is beneficial to learning.

Notification of parents will take place through the student handbook, and individual teacher at the beginning of the course.
