345.5 - Honor Programs

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of academic achievement. Honors procedures are in place to reward students in grade 7-12 for their academic excellence.

Each student will be eligible to graduate from high school with honors. The District will recognize two levels of honors: <u>Graduation with Honors</u> and <u>Graduation with High Honors</u>. The criterion to be used is the 7th semester cumulative grade point average. Students receiving <u>Graduation with Honors</u> will have a 3.500-3.749. Students receiving <u>Graduation with High Honors</u> will have a 3.750-4.000. Grade point averages will be considered to the .000 place and will not be rounded up.

A Valedictorian and Salutatorian will be named.
