	Instruction

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Field Trips:

The Green Lake School District recognizes the educational value of student travel. During field trips, school rules shall remain in effect from the time of departure to the time of return. Consequences for breaking rules will include necessary modification due to being off school grounds.

Overnight Trips:

A trip request, with a tentative trip itinerary, shall be approved by the board prior to any fundraising for the trip. Any changes in trip itinerary affecting the duration of the trip needs to be brought to the board for additional approval. Both parents and students will be required to sign the approved administrative letter, signed by the principal, before leaving on a school sponsored trip. Any change in the administrative letter will be brought to the attention of the Board.

For serious behavioral infractions the student may be sent home at the parent's expense.
