## 361.1 - Selection of Instructional Materials

The legal responsibility for instructional materials used in the Green Lake School District rests ultimately with the Board. Responsibility for selection of instructional materials shall be delegated to the professionally trained staff employed by the district.

Selection of instructional materials may involve many people: teachers, administrators, media specialists, staff, community members, and students.

The Green Lake School District shall not discriminate in the selection and evaluation of instructional and library materials or media on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, background, socio-economic status, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
