374-Student Fundraising

When authorized by an administrator, students may, under adult supervision, raise funds for school-related purposes. Such fundraising shall be conducted as specified under the rules and regulations of the school board and shall not be conducted in any manner that would violate state or local laws.

Funds raised for the benefit of school groups or organizations, or for school activities, where such groups, organizations or activities, are subsidized by district funds, shall be maintained by the district business office and shall be disbursed in accordance with established procedures.

1. Students under the age of 12 shall be permitted to participate in a fund-raising sale provided written approval has been obtained from the student's parent/guardian.
2. Students under the age of nine or each group containing one or more students under the age of nine must be physically accompanied by a parent or a person at least 16 years of age when working in a fundraising sale.
3. All funds originating from school-sponsored fundraising projects shall become the property of the student groups. Every reasonable effort is to be made to insure that funds raised by a school-sponsored group for an approved and specified purpose are utilized for that purpose.
4. All funds originating from school-sponsored fundraising will be processed through the business office's school activity fund.
