377 – Interscholastic Athletics

Athletics is an important part of education and shall be based upon the same sound philosophical principles that guide academics. Athletic participation is a voluntary activity providing an extended educational opportunity for students to develop a sense of self-discipline and teamwork for the betterment of the individual and the team.

Interscholastic athletics shall:

1. develop within the students the determination and dedication necessary to complete their goals.
2. develop the self-discipline necessary for a successful life.
3. develop a willingness to place the good of the group before the desires of the individual.
4. to provide opportunities to exemplify and observe ethical conduct.

All student athletes are required to attend an Activity Code Meeting.

The district shall maintain membership in the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA) subscribing to the rules and regulations of the WIAA in an effort to keep athletics at a high standard of educational values. Student athletes shall be expected to abide by the Green Lake School Activity Code.

The District shall not discriminate in the opportunity provided for participation in athletic programs or activities, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. This does not prohibit placing a student in a program or activity based on objective standards of individual performance, providing separate programs in interscholastic athletics for males and females if such programs are comparable in type, scope, and support from the District, or providing separate toilet, locker, and shower facilities if they are comparable. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
