420 – Student Admissions

Any student being admitted to the Green Lake School District shall reside within the established boundaries of the district, except as otherwise provided. The administration shall verify the age and residence of children enrolled in the district’s schools.

The principal shall have the authority to determine the grade level at which a student shall be placed.

Students transferring from other schools are required to provide a transcript of academic accomplishments at the previous school, or the address from which these data may be secured. If sufficient academic transcript information is not available, a student will be evaluated by the principal and pupil services staff to determine proper grade placement.

Parents or guardians of students admitted to the district’s elementary and secondary schools shall present immunization records as required by state law.

The Green Lake School District shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program, activity or facilities usage on the basis of sex, sexual orientation, race, national origin, ancestry, color creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
