421 – Admission to Kindergarten and First Grade

Children who reside in Green Lake School District and who meet the state entrance requirements may be enrolled in kindergarten and/or first grade. Kindergartners will be registered at the Kindergarten Round-Up held the previous spring, and enrollment will be completed by the opening day of school in fall.

All children requesting admission to kindergarten or first grade must have their fifth and sixth birthdays, respectively, on/or before September 1. The Green Lake School Board may admit children to kindergarten or first grade below the legal age in accordance with established early admission guidelines and state law.

The administration shall verify the age of children enrolling in the district schools.
