447.1 - Use of Force by School Personnel

Corporal punishment shall not be used in the Green Lake School District. School officials may use reasonable and necessary force under the following conditions:

- 1. To quell a disturbance or prevent an act that threatens physical injury to any person.
- 2. To obtain possession of a weapon or other dangerous object within a student's control.
- 3. For the purpose of self-defense or the defense of others, or for the protection of property in accordance with state statutes.
- 4. To remove a disruptive student from school premises, a motor vehicle or school-sponsored activity.
- 5. To prevent a student from inflicting harm on him/herself or to protect the safety of others.

Incidental, minor or reasonable physical contact designed to maintain order and control may also be used. Procedures will be developed for restraint of students.
