

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF GREEN LAKE POLICY	453.3 – Communicable Disease Control
	Students

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The Green Lake School District shall establish and maintain appropriate health standards regarding cases of known or suspected communicable diseases, as well as the reporting of disease and disease control.

In an effort to promote the good health of students and employees the District will provide educational opportunities to students and employees regarding measures that can be taken to reduce the risk of contracting or transmitting communicable diseases. This will be accomplished through the health education curriculum and staff development activities.

Students and employees may be excluded from school and/or related activities if they are suspected of or diagnosed as having a communicable disease, as defined by Wisconsin Division of Health Communicable Disease Guidelines, that poses a significant health risk to others or that renders them unable to adequately pursue their studies or perform their jobs.

In recognition that an individual's health status is personal and private, the District shall handle information regarding students and employees with suspected or confirmed communicable diseases in accordance with state and federal laws and Green Lake School District policy. The District will follow procedures regarding confidentiality of student and employee health records, and at the same time comply with applicable public health reporting requirements.
