**453.5 – Physical Examinations/Health Screenings**

Green Lake School District may recommend periodic health examinations of students entering kindergarten, and at other appropriate age milestones during a students academic career. Health screening shall be provided to students in accordance with current health practice guidelines and will take into consideration community resources for adequate treatment/referral. The results of recommended health examination shall be summarized in the pupil physical health record required and maintained for each enrolled student. Parents and/or legal guardians are notified of screening results and given recommendations for appropriate follow-up as needed.

All students participating in interscholastic athletics; must secure health examinations in accordance with Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA) rules.

The school nurse is responsible for compiling and maintaining accurate records of findings, referrals and other follow-up activities.

The Green Lake School District shall establish and maintain employee physical examination and tuberculosis screening on employment.

The results of the employee physical examination and tuberculosis screening shall be summarized on the Physician Record of Employee Examination and maintained for each employee, in employee administrative files.
