731.1 – Locker Room Privacy

Locker rooms are provided for the use of physical education students, athletes and other activity groups or individuals authorized by the principal or Board policy. The District recognizes the privacy rights of individuals using the locker room and shall take reasonable measures to protect an individual's privacy.

Under no circumstances may cameras, video recorders, or other recording devices be used in the locker room. Also, no person may use a cell phone to capture, record or transfer a representation of a nude or partially nude person in the locker room or to take any other photo or video image of a person in the locker room.

Individuals may enter or remain in the locker room to interview or seek information from an individual in the locker room only under the following conditions:

- 1) At no time will students be interviewed in the locker room.
- 2) Media representatives or other individuals (e.g., college scouts) may interview a coach in the locker room only if no students are present in the locker room at the time.
- 3) An individual may interview or seek information from an adult using the locker room only with the permission of that individual.

Students and staff violating this policy shall be subject to school disciplinary action and possible legal referral, if applicable. Other persons violating the policy may be subject to penalties outlined in state law. The principal or his/her designee shall be responsible for enforcing this policy.

This policy shall be posted in every locker room in the District and shall be publicized annually.
